

42nd Annual - ARNOLD SPRING PEDDLER'S FAIRE

May 23 & 24, 2020 ~ Memorial Day Weekend

Hours: 9am - 4pm daily

WHERE: Highway 4 in Downtown Arnold, amongst the pines and redwoods - on the grounds of Bristol's Ranch House Cafe'.

ABOUT THE SHOW: Antiques, collectibles, crafts, art, new and gently used merchandise, prepared foods & pre-packaged foods (no health permits are necessary for any food booths), and pretty much anything else can be sold. Nothing illegal, dangerous, or offensive (use good judgment) will be allowed.

MOST IMPORTANT RULE: ALL NEW VENDORS MUST INCLUDE PHOTOS OF THEIR STOCKED BOOTH SHOWING ALL ITEMS THEY INTEND TO SELL. Many vendors sell many different types of items, and it's impossible for us to tell by simply stating 'toys', 'fashion accessories', etc. So ~ We MUST see photos of your fully stocked booth. We do limit 'like' categories for the integrity of the Faire & in fairness to all vendors.

PREVIOUS VENDORS: If you are bringing anything other than what you've sold in the past, please send us a photo for approval FIRST. If it's not listed on your application and in your display photo, don't bring it!

DETAILS: Spaces are 10' x 10' minimum; some are deeper. All spaces will be pre-assigned. No aisles are provided between spaces. Vendors are to provide all display materials, tables, canopies, etc. Spaces are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis, until we're full. Particulars on set-up times and procedures will be sent upon acceptance, along with motel and campgrounds info in the area. We always TRY to accommodate your special requests or needs with regard to your space, if you let us know in advance ~ when applying if possible. We do allow cars to remain behind SOME spaces along one perimeter row ONLY, provided they are parked in it soon enough so as not to disturb any adjoining booths. These spaces are limited and fill up very early, as many past participants request them each year. If you've requested a space to keep your vehicle BEHIND you, that vehicle CANNOT be moved in & out during the show. All other vehicles can be brought in to unload and load at or near your space, and then removed from the grounds, but parked very close by. RV parking is limited on our adjacent back street, and is available on a first-parked basis, and needn't be moved during the weekend. No hookups; but water and portable toilets are close by. Absolutely NO fires of any kind, including hibachis, are allowed or tolerated. Please note ~ unless you are an 'occasional' seller (like a couple of yard sales annually, or JUST this Peddler's Faire, etc., you MUST have a resale permit; contact the CA State Board of Equalization for a temporary permit.

ADVERTISING: We advertise extensively throughout all three counties of the Mother Lode, as well as hang a huge banner across Highway 4 in Arnold. We also reach papers from Sacramento through Modesto, and the Faire is well-supported by the locals and the 'weekenders/tourists' ~ that are mostly second-home owners from the Bay Area.

NO-NO's: After many complaints from customers and vendors, we will no longer allow stink bombs/any-kind-of-bombs or poppers to be sold. Anything offensive, illegal, dangerous, or not listed on your application will not be allowed, and we reserve the right to have you remove anything we deem as such. No fireworks of any kind will be allowed. Please, NO PETS on the grounds during the show, with the exception of service dogs (NOT 'emotional' service dogs.)

CRAFTSPEOPLE: If you make your product, you may be interested in our other shows, which are strictly juried and limited in all categories. Refer to our website: www.afterthegoldrushfestivals.com for info/applications which you can download, or call us for information: 925/372-8961

SPACE FEES: \$100 - general space - 10 x 10
\$120 - food booths, OR pre-packaged food booths (no health permits are necessary)

NO spaces can be reserved for just one day. Refunds before May 1 are subject to a \$50 handling fee. NO refunds after May 1. The Faire is held rain or shine.
