

48th Annual LABOR DAY WEEKEND ARTS & CRAFTS FESTIVAL, ARNOLD, CA
September 5 & 6, 2020 Hours: Sat: 10 - 5; Sun: 10 - 4

AFTER THE GOLD RUSH will again be sponsoring the 48th Annual Labor Day Weekend Crafts Festival in Arnold, CA. This mountain resort town enjoys one of its busiest weekends over this holiday, and this is the end-of-summer celebration. The Festival is open to all artists and craftspeople and food vendors, including pre-packaged foods (no health permits are necessary for any food booths), subject to juried entry by 4 - 6 photos of your work, 1 of your display and 1 of your studio/work area (even if it's your dining room table!) Booth spaces are 10' x 10', and all exhibitors must provide all booth materials. This is usually a fairly hot weekend, and bringing awnings or other shade is recommended.

The Festival will feature continuous live music from 'Homegrown' out of Modesto – they've been with the Festival for 35+ years. Publicity is extensive in the three surrounding counties, as well as a banner hung across Highway 4 in town. The Ebbetts's Pass Fire Dept. serves local beers.

Entry fees are the same as last year: \$210 for a 10' x 10' space for arts/crafts, and \$230 for food vendors - including pre-packaged foods. It is advantageous to apply early, as we strictly limit categories in fairness to all exhibitors. We hold the Festival to 55 booths. Any work not juried in advance will not be allowed, and it and/or you would be asked to leave with no refund.

Upon acceptance, we will send you all pertinent set-up information, motels, campgrounds, & directions. No refunds will be made after August 1. Motels are much cheaper in Angels Camp – 20 miles down the hill – and we strongly suggest making reservations early over this holiday weekend. Refunds before August 1 are subject to a \$75 processing fee.

Fill out the application below, cut off, and send it along with 4 - 5 photos of your work, a display photo, a studio photo, & your application fee. Send a self-addressed, stamped (71¢) envelope if you want your photos/materials returned. All notifications of acceptance/rejection will be E-MAILED within 2 months of applying - unless you have provided a self-addressed, stamped envelope for notice.
